## Station Facilities

### CAM & DURSLEY STATION FACILITIES

- Car parking: 90 (no charge)
- Drop off area: Bristol (southbound) platform only
- Bus stop and shelter
- Footbridge – ramped access to northbound (Gloucester) platform
- Ticket machine
- Live Travel Information point
- Help point
- Waiting shelters on both platforms
- No toilets

## Onward Travel

### Bus Services

Cam and Dursley station is connected to nearby town and villages by bus services calling at the station and from stops of Draycott Road (approx. 10 minutes walk).

**Service 65** links Dursley, Cam, Eastington, Stonehouse, Quedgeley and Gloucester via Draycott Road. Runs Monday to Saturday with a limited service on Sundays. Peak time services call at the station.

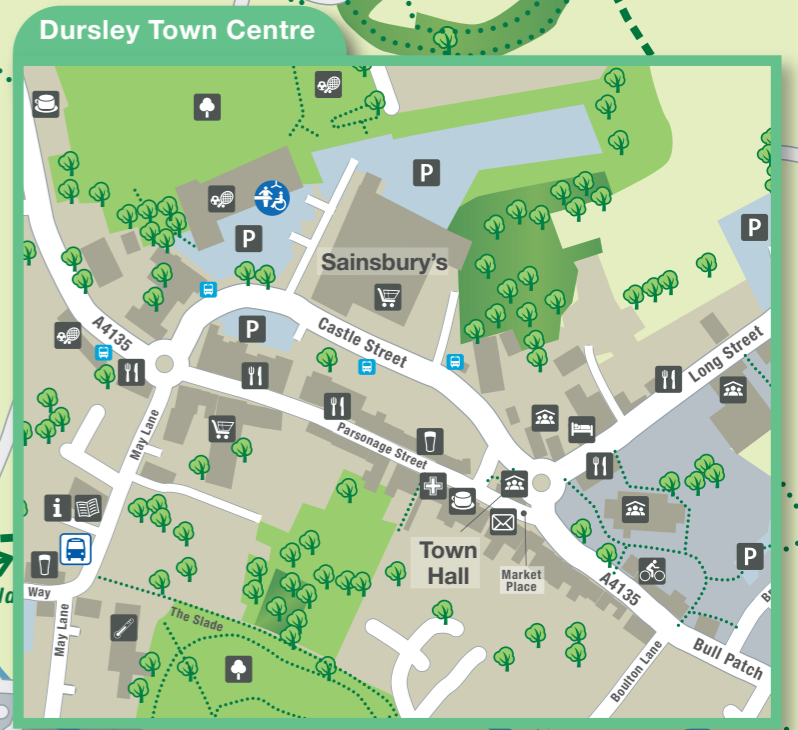
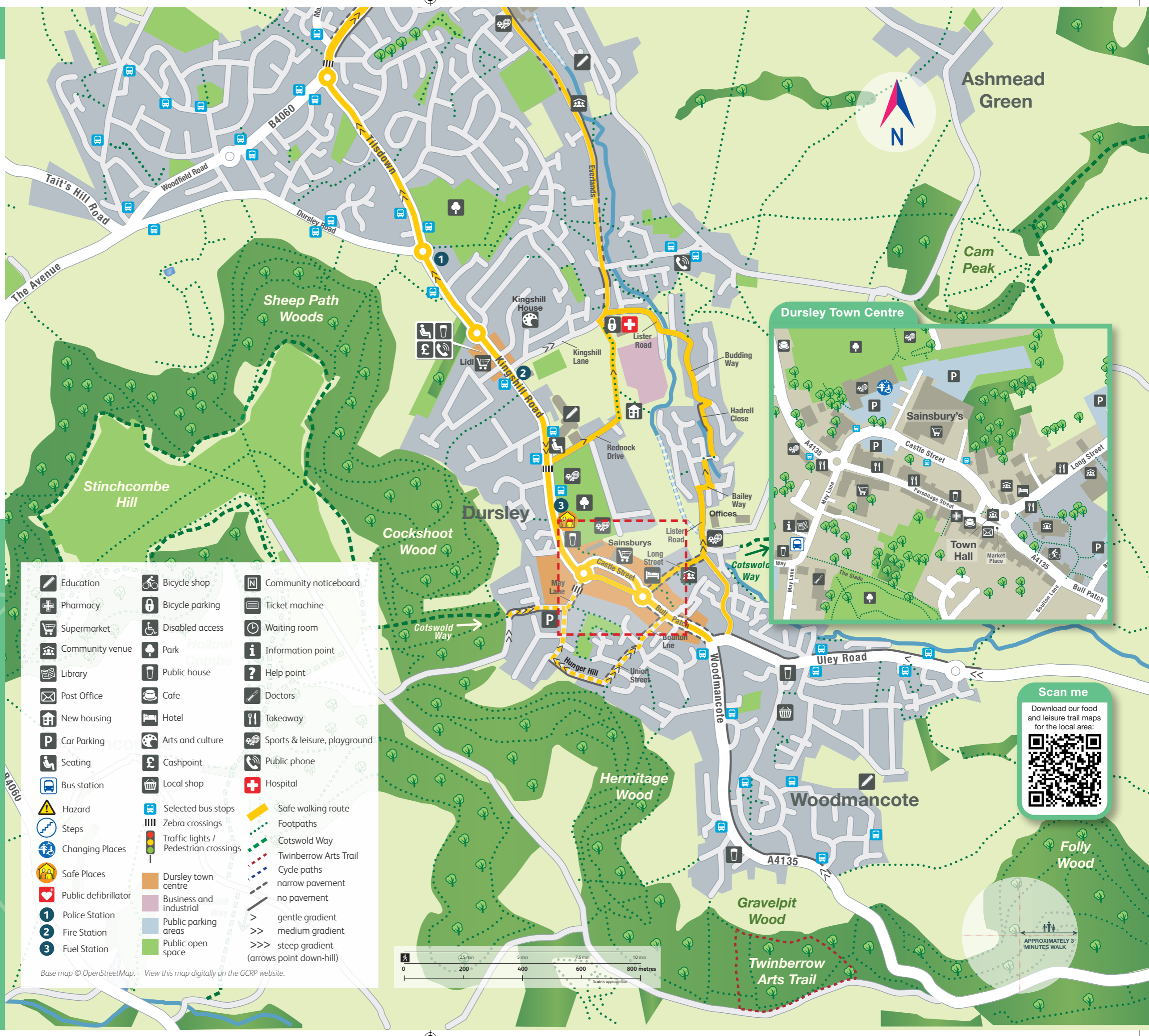
