Community Toilet Scheme

Station Facilities

STONEHOUSE STATION FACILITIES

-  Car parking: 25
-  Disabled bays: 1
-  Drop off area: informal
-  Ticket Machine: Platform 2
-  Cycle parking: Platform 1 - 3; Platform 2 - none
-  Footbridge (no lifts). See map for alternative route
-  Induction loop: one per platform
-  Help Points: one per platform
-  Seating: both platforms (shelters provided)

TICKET OFFICE OPEN
(Platform 2)
06:10-10:45 Mon-Fri
07:10-10:40 Sat
Closed on Sundays
