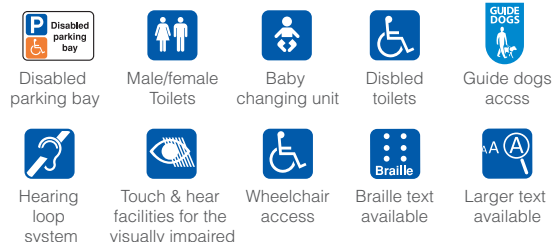

These are places within the immediate area surrounding a railway station that offer a place of refuge during times of need.

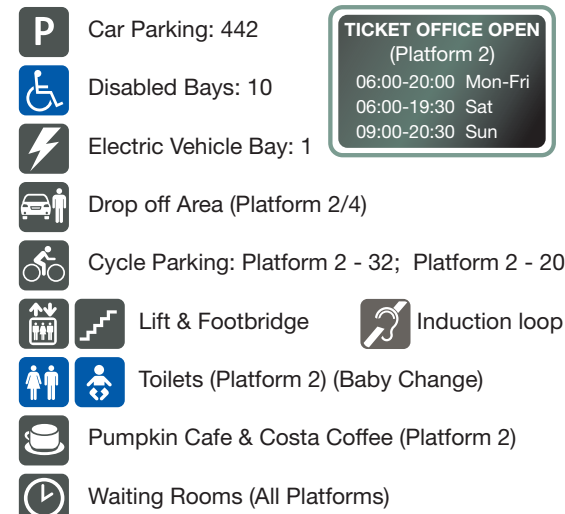
