

Nutshell Trail - - - -

Exit the railway station from platform 2 onto Burdett Road, turn right onto High Street, at the Co-op turn left onto Laburnum Walk, continue into Berryfields Sports Ground along the righthand side of Park. Cross Bristol road at the traffic lights, onto Church Road. Turn right into St Cyrs Churchyard towards the canal, cross at The Ocean bridge and follow the track down hill staying left. Go under the railway viaduct, over the lovely weir then left along a public footpath towards the sewage works, keep these on your right and follow the path under the railway bridge. Turn left into farm fields on signposted public footpath, keep following this well marked footpath for 1km until you reach Stanley Downton Turn left at the end and left again onto Downton Road, at the Paper and Bag Mills, turn left onto a footpath and follow it all the way to Nutshell bridge, cross the canal again and you will find yourself back in St Cyrs church yard, from here retrace your steps back to the railway station.

Vineyard Trail - - - -

Exit the railway station from platform 1, cross over to Verney Road, at the end of Verney Road turn right onto the public footpath marked by a green sign. Follow path up the hill and past Doverow Woods for 1km - there are several benches with great views along here. Turn right where the footpath meets the Cotswold way and follow these signs downhill passing Woodchester Vineyard on your right. Cross the railway footbridge and turn right onto Pearcroft Road then right onto High Street and check out the lovely independent shops of Stonehouse.

Alpaca Trail - - - -

Exit the railway station from platform 1 and take a left turn on to Russell Street then immediately right onto Rowcroft, continue along King Street (pedestrianised) turn left onto Gloucester Street Carry straight on, past the mini roundabout on your left towards Beeches Green and fork right uphill onto Folly Lane, keep left and follow public footpath signs into fields, signposted for Painswick. Follow the footpath up hill to Oakbrook community farm and micro dairy. Cross over Wick Street continue on the public footpath to Hammonds Farm (home of the alpacas) turn right from the field and right again, cross Wick Street, follow the footpath uphill then right onto a clearly marked footpath just after the woods. Follow this all the way down to the allotments, turn right onto Folly Lane and then left onto Springfield Road, cut through Sidney Herbert Memorial Park to take you back into Stroud and the railway station.

Icecream Trail - - - -

Exit the railway station from platform 2 and turn right onto Cheapside. Then left onto Wallbridge and left onto the canal by the Lock Keepers Café. follow the towpath to Capels Mill keeping the canal and viaduct on your left follow signs for Rodborough, cross the River Frome on a small wooden footbridge then turn right up into fields follow public footpath uphill (stay left). At the top turn left onto Rodborough Lane and follow it for 1.5km cross Butterrow Hill and continue to Montserrat (1.5km total). Turn right onto clearly marked public footpath which takes you up onto Rodborough Common and the Wintones Icecream Factory.
