

### Harbour Trail - - - -

Exit Lydney Mainline railway station left onto Station Road, cross over, on your right a signpost for Harbour Walk takes you 1.9km to Lydney Harbour, a fascinating scheduled monument, complete with ship graveyard and visitor information hub plus a lovely new café, several great spots for picnics and outstanding views across the Severn.

### Town Trail - - - -

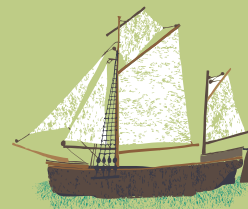
Exit Lydney Mainline railway station right onto Station Rd for 0.5km, turn left at the roundabout. Turn right onto a track running alongside the steam railway bringing you to St Marys Halt, just before the bridge turn left into St Marys Church, follow the path through the churchyard, turn right towards the war memorial, passing underneath a black and white half timbered row of houses with a colourful mural decorating the walls. Bathurst Park is a glorious green space with a café, toilets, excellent play park and ornamental gardens. At the end of the park turn right up Bathurst Park Road, at the Fire Station turn right onto Hill Street, cross the railway tracks with caution and follow this road, passing an array of shops and cafes. At the junction with Hips Social Café turn right, onto Hams Rd, towards the bus station. After B&M Car Park fork right towards the recreation ground, keeping the river on your right follow the path past the sports facilities and around the lake exiting the park at the roundabout, sign posted for Lydney Mainline station.

### Town Trail & Dean Forest Railway Trail - - - -

Extend the Town Trail into the Forest, starting at Hips Social Café turn left onto Albert St and follow it up the hill where it becomes Springfield Rd. At a sharp right bend a footpath opens into the forest, follow this path through ancient woodland until you reach a small stream, the path bends sharply round to the left opening into a grassy area, keep left - the path takes you downhill. After the electricity substation cross Forest Rd to Norchard station and café. Take Forest Rd towards Lydney, after the station Carpark, at Millrough cottages, a Public Footpath takes you left back into the forest, follow this uphill, it crosses your original path and through a gate brings you out at a fantastic little playing field with spectacular views. From here turn right onto Primrose Hill, Springfield Rd and eventually Albert St back to your starting point. Here re-join the pink Town Trail to Lydney Mainline Station.

### Lydney Park Estate Trail - - - -

Starting at Lydney Mainline railway station use the pink Town Trail to reach St Marys Church, turn right onto Church Rd for 0.5km. At the Town Hall turn left onto High Street, then right, after the Police Station, onto Watery Lane, Follow path through Lydney Park estate towards the sawmill with wonderful views of the River Severn and beyond. At the sawmill turn right onto a public footpath. Follow the main path through the woods, as it heads uphill again you can see Bream Rd ahead, 100m before the road turn right onto an unmarked path through the trees, a gate leads you onto a public footpath through fields alongside Bream Rd. Over a stile at the end of the field, continue until you reach the Hospital. Turn right, then left onto Grove Rd, following it downhill, turn right onto Bream Rd and then left onto Hill St at the Fire station, re-join the pink Town Trail to Lydney Mainline station.
